- f Students will be required to take a short Blackboard and online training module as established by CUW's Office of Distance and Continuing Education (OCDE) department.
- f All credits earned in the CUP Metorograms will be eligible for transfer and application to the Educational Administration equirements. Only courses with B grades or better will be accepted.
- f Students transferring from CUP to CUW to obtain a master's degree may be eligible for licensure endorsement through CUW. Further coursework would be required and all Wisconsin licensure requirements need to be met through the
